Ministry Is Still Happening!



IV New: "InterVarsity Resolved to Pursue Justice and Reconciliation"

InterVarsity's president, Tom Lin, released a statement on June 1 in light of the turmoil and sadness our country is facing. He writes:

As President, I reiterate InterVarsity's commitment

to pray for and act toward a more robust biblical ministry of reconciliation and restoration... As a fellowship with one-third of our staff and more than one-half

of the core students in our campus ministry who are people of color, I am committed to pressing InterVarsity to more fully reflect biblical justice and reconciliation in the ways we minister together. I also know we have a long way to go. Our need for revival—individually, corporately, and nationally—is clearer than ever. 


