The Entire Letter is below:

Thank you for reading about and praying for our missionaries, countries and people locally and globally! **Dear Friends**,

Praises = Recently I took a walk in our neighbourhood by myself (Kathleen was in the garden working away) and:

C an older gentlemen at the end of the first block invited me in for a cup of coffee. We are not suppose to be inside yet, but neither of us had a problem with it, so I had a cup and listened as C just spoke about his depression (due to being hit as a policeman many years ago in London), and about his father who died in India during the 2nd World War. C is a practicing Roman Catholic and showed me his Missal which he reads daily.

After 45 minutes I called Kathleen to let her know I was okay and I would be home in 5 minutes.

R & D - a couple in a friend relationship (both of their partners died years ago), then met me on the way home from C. D asked me for a ride this Friday to a near-by town for her hearing to be checked. We are happy to take her. She also wanted to make sure we would stay until she was done (which we assured her we would).

Across from R's house is a small play area, and a lady with twins was playing. She is someone we have talked to once before and told her about K in our church who also has twins about the same age. That was another 5 minute talk - mainly about how she loves the play area because it has a fence around it.

Heading home again, M appeared and waved me over and told me about his project in the back garden. He is making a space for building wooden tables (as a hobby), and then showed me some of his work on his phone. He is good! Saying good-bye (after meeting his father in law) he then invited Kathleen and myself over for a BBQ sometime after June 21st when everything should be totally open again in the UK.

When I got home (20 minutes after leaving C) Kathleen and I rejoiced together over each of these meeting. Each relationship has developed because of the lockdown and just walking around our neighbourhood each day. We do not see these people every day, but probably each week. In meeting them we try to show interest and kindness to each one. We try to reflect Christ, so they might all know HIM.

Kathleen also said I might have to walk by myself more often!
