Foster the City expanded outside of California earlier this month and is now partnering with churches and families in Northern Nevada. Today in the greater Reno area, dozens of children enter foster care every month and the heartbreaking reality is that there are currently no open homes ready to receive these kids. Recently, nearly 60 people gathered at our first Interest Meeting in Northern Nevada to learn how they can make a difference for vulnerable kids and families in this city.

FTC is raising funds through two Spartan-style Races: 12/4 (San Francisco) and 12/11 (Los Angeles) Run, Climb, Jump through obstacles on behalf of vulnerable children. fosterthecity.org/race Their goal is \$100,000. Our generosity today will help more children in foster care experience love and stability in our cities.

This year, our church is launching an ongoing Foster Care Ministry Fund to support preschool tuition costs for potential foster child(ren) to attend Tiny Treasures Preschool and the FTC/BACBC Ministry.
