Update on J & D who are actively preparing to enter ministry to a creative access region of the world - ahead of them are last minute preparations, goodbyes to friends and family, dependence on the Lord to provide for them. They are grateful for the prayers which with God's help has enabled them to get this point after many delays.

Praises for the encouragement they have received while training and from their supporting churches and friends.

Praises that they are healthy and medical needs were taken care of before leaving.

Praise that they have been able to find good homes for most of their belongings including a charity for their furniture to help local Afghan refugees.

Praise that they will not likely face a period of quarantine upon their arrival in their ministry region.

Pray for them to find a place to live as they continue to study and seek wisdom for a more long-term place after their training and that while they will make mistakes in a new place—that God will use those times for good and establish further opportunities later. Pray that they will find favor and gracious people.

Pray for them as they travel, continue language and culture training (some Western etiquette is considered rude where they will be), spiritual protection as they embark into a spiritual battlefield, pray for them to strengthen their spiritual disciplines and that God will send people of peace to welcome them and help them adapt.
