Since The Beginning

Scan the QR code to watch our 25th anniversary video. Over a decade ago, I was teaching a conference in Fresno. The participants were on a break, and I started a conversation with a man who was part of the staff at U.C. Davis. He told me that he was part of a group that had been going through the Becoming What God Intended workbook for five years straight. After finishing a cycle, they would start all over again. I think that they held the time record for any group! Then he said three people within the group changed their minds about committing suicide because of the truths in the book. Seeing that I looked surprised, he said, "I was one of the three."





Over the last twenty-five years, individuals have shared how what we teach literally saved their lives. More often than that, many, many, more have shared how the ministry of Becoming What God Intended transformed their lives. What a joy that is! Over the last twenty-five years, we have seen people become believers. We have seen marriages transformed for the better. Addictions have been eliminated. Joy has entered unhappy hearts. A continual part of this ministry and its great characteristic is that hearts are changed.

The Great Expansion

About fifteen years ago I was invited to speak at a mental health conference in B sponsored by the Communist Youth League. After speaking at a university, the officials invited me back, and then subsequently asked me to bring teams of therapists and psychologists to do training for them in mental health. Everyone I took was a committed evangelical Christian. For over a dozen years we were lecturing in the universities and counseling centers of B and other parts of the country. The *Skills for Living Curriculum - A Bridge to the Gospel*, has been used to train tens of thousands throughout B and beyond. Outside of the lectures we would share Christ.



At the same time, we were invited to speak for the house churches, the international churches, and missionary folks. Out of the blue of Heaven, a group of nuns attended one of our trainings and invited us to their convent to speak on the Trinity. The Mother Superior who gave the invitation said, "It is confusing. We need help understanding it." They told me I was the first male permitted to stay at the convent!

We have not traveled to Asia in three years but in actual fact, we have been present in Asia and Australia through distance education. What is delightful to us is that we continue to be told these truths are changing lives. Our Head to Heart Discipleship program in particular has had the greatest impact. Our presence is growing in Australia, and we believe the Spirit of God is sovereignly opening the door for us in that continent.

Now we believe God the Father wants us to have world-class distance education classes. As a result, our Executive Director, Gayle, is working on a M.S. Degree from Johns Hopkins in Educational Technology. Hopkins university has one of the best education programs in the world.
