## From today's bulletin / Missions Report from Missions Team

InterVarsity Christian Fellowship (Northern CA, Southern OR) – In the past 6 months, Derek and Chelsea Jung have visited campuses, encouraged leaders, and prayed with partners, including a college in Klamath Falls. They hosted multiple meals every week to foster community for students. Their students grew in prayer and spiritual intimacy with God. Their campus activities included studying the lives of Abraham and Moses with a major theme being God's presence and desire to partner with His human creations. They ended the ministry year with:

12 decisions of faith from across the campuses and

over 100 students involved in 6 campus fellowships

16 (Sixteen) Student Leaders were developed,

- (8) eight in-person Bible Studies/Community Groups were replanted, and
- (3) three student interns were trained.

They also coordinated and led a Spring Break Conference at Catalina Island.

Your support and prayers allow them to share Christ's Good News of hope and resurrection to colleges in far Northern California and Southern Oregon. You have given them the means to develop and disciple students for life-long leadership, weekly Bible studies and dinners that draw students to Christ and Community, empower Campus outreach and retreats and help cover travel and technology costs for planting ministry on six (6) campuses.


### Outreach in fire season

#### **The Love Our Neighbor Weekend**

This was a wonderful weekend with 20 staff and students from across NorCal. Chelsea directed the weekend. Derek gave a sermon on Shalom. The Lord helped us recover from sickness swiftly; thank you for praying over us.

We spent time serving at the Jesus Farm which offers agricultural vocational training for houseless folks and sells its produce to support the efforts of the Jesus Center ministry which seeks to bless and dignify those in poverty. We were also hosted by amazing Christians and agents of the Kingdom. Students are learning what it looks like to love their communities, pray for campus, and God's heart to be near those who are hurting.
