# Becoming What God Intended Ministries (BWGI US, Asia, Australia), Dr. David Eckman

BWGI Ministries now offers a comprehensive 5-Course Discipleship and Evangelism Concentration with courses and materials for individuals, organizations, churches, seminaries, and Bible Schools. The five courses are BC101: Foundations of the Spiritual Life, BC102: Head to Heart Discipleship Small Group Experience, BC103: Theology of Romans, BC104: Theology of Emotions, and BC105: Skills for Living.

The Skills for Living course is an introduction to mental health principles. The secular version was originally used in China to help answer questions about what it means to be human--male or female, what is emotional health, what do healthy relationships look like. Secondly, the course created a platform for introducing the Gospel and the need for a relationship with God as the answer to not only mental health issues, but ultimately the question of "what is my purpose in life?"

BWGI Ministries has had opportunities to expand their ministry to Australia. Your prayers are appreciated for Dr. David Eckman and the growth of BWGI Ministries for God's kingdom.
