Silver Lining Missions (China, Asia) – Their mission is to serve underprivileged and disabled children and their families through various centers in Asia. Here are two examples of what takes place at their centers. At the Myanmar Silver Lining Rehabilitation Center, the children are adapting to the return of onsite classes. Pray for the health of the staff and for a spirit of humility as they work together to bless those they serve. One social worker who was baptized over a year ago has experienced a lot of stress while dealing with an outbreak of patients' measles. Another staff member is responsible for the Gospel ministry at the center, sharing the Gospel with parents through various activities.

At the Vietnam Dac Thang Community Health Education Center, pray that more children will come to be helped by the services offered. Their goal is to help children with their physical, mental, and spiritual well-being and reduce negative behaviors. A couples' retreat was successfully completed with several couples making professions of faith and a Mid-Autumn Festival was held at the center.
