



Job Description: K-8 PE TEACHER, SPORTS COACH

HOURS: Part-time or full-time positions available, 10 months of scheduled work paid over 12 months to follow the school year and teacher schedule

ACCOUNTABILITY: This is an exempt position and reports to the Athletics Director and/or CCS Administrator overseeing Athletics programs.

PURPOSE: To foster a positive, welcoming, and caring culture in the school ministries through physical education and athletic programs.

PAY: Part-time positions by sport season are paid via a stipend of \$1250 per season. Full-time positions are based on teaching scale (education, years of K-12 class experience). Athletic positions and salary determination are for a period of one school year/sports season and require yearly School Board approval.

REGULAR DUTIES:

- Must conduct regular practice and team conditioning. Some practice and conditioning may happen out of season
- The ability to motivate and lead student-athletes with positivity
- Instruct the team on game strategies, techniques, and skill building under the coach's direction
- Demonstrates strong leadership skills and sportsmanship
- Acts as a positive Christian role model on and off the court/field/site, etc.
- Engages with local and community programs related to the sport
- Maintains competency in CCS Way, event procedures, coaching techniques, and general information about all aspects of the sport.
- Communicates effectively with the Athletic Department and assistant/support sports staff regarding scheduling, budget, injuries, etc.
- Communicates effectively with the local sports community in support of their program
- Communicate effectively with parents and the school community regarding all aspects of the program
- Follows school policies and procedures regarding facility use, transportation, purchasing, fundraising, etc.
- Provides adequate supervision of events until all athletes have left the facilities
- Maintains adequate records of rosters, stats, and awards
- Effectively recognizes the efforts of student-athletes and participates/plans special events in this regard (banquets, Sports night, etc.)
- Establishes and maintains the importance of the meaning of student-athlete, including check-ins with all stakeholders regarding student school-sports-family life balance

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Bachelors degree required from an accredited college or university
- Teaching credential preferred
- Experience in coaching middle school sports and running youth sports programs preferred
- Experience working with elementary and middle school-age students
- Strong verbal and written communication skills, leadership, and organizational skills
- Ability to use Google Suites (Slides, Docs, Calendar, Sheets, etc.)
- Evangelical Christian commitment and lifestyle consistent with BACBC's Articles of Faith
